Colorado Springs Airport is approximately 8.3 miles/15 minutes from The Broadmoor. COS boasts multiple carriers that offer varied routes to virtually all cities in North America and major cities worldwide. This ultimately allows the airport to provide convenient flight schedules and competitive airfares. The airport handles around 106 arrivals and departures per day and is served by nine airlines. COS has non-stop service to 11 U.S. cities, as well as convenient connecting flights.

Denver International Airport is approximately 89 miles/90 minutes from The Broadmoor. DIA is home to more than 30 commercial Airlines, including regional carriers and charters, which offer more than 140 domestic and international destinations with nonstop service. DIA served 49.86 million passengers in 2007, ranking the fifth-busiest airport in North America and tenth-busiest in the world.
