STEPHEN BARTOLIN, JR.: CHAIRMAN & CEO OF THE BRO^ADMOOR

Colorado Springs, Colorado (Spring/Summer 2008)...Mr. Bartolin became president of The BRO^ADMOOR in Colorado Springs, Colo. in July 1991. In 1996, he was elevated to president and CEO and in 2002 was named chairman and CEO. During Mr. Bartolin's tenure, The BRO^ADMOOR has added 150 rooms (for a total of 700), a new golf club, a world-class spa facility, a new pool complex, the Lakeside Suites, a \$35 million restoration of the original main building, the 60,000 sq. ft. Broadmoor Hall, Summit restaurant, the Mountain Golf Course, Cheyenne Lodge, 23 retail shops, the Broadmoor Resort Community and a thorough refurbishment of the entire property, grounds and golf courses.

Mr. Bartolin is a graduate of Youngstown State University in Youngstown, Ohio, where he earned a bachelor's degree in business. He joined The Greenbrier in 1975, where he held management positions in golf operations, front office, reservations, food and beverage and conference services and sales.

In 1980, Mr. Bartolin became director of convention services at the Opryland Hotel in Nashville, Tenn., a position he held for five years until he was promoted to resident manager. After leaving Opryland in September 1987, Mr. Bartolin returned to The Greenbrier as general manager of the 6,500 acre, 650-room, Mobil Five-Star and AAA Five-Diamond destination resort.

In addition to his responsibilities at The BRO^ADMOOR, Mr. Bartolin also serves as president and CEO of the Manitou and Pikes Peak Railway Company, the Broadmoor Development Company and The BRO^ADMOOR Golf Club. He also serves on the board of The BRO^ADMOOR's parent company, The Oklahoma Publishing Company, and the Penrose-St. Francis Health Care System.

Mr. Bartolin was named 1997 Resort Executive of the Year and 2005 Colorado Hotel Executive of the Year.
