## **JUNIOR GOLF INSTRUCTION OPTIONS**

Colorado Springs, CO (Spring/ Summer 2008)...The BRO<sup>A</sup>DMOOR not only caters to adult golfers, but the staff offers an excellent training program for young players from age 5 to 14\*.

### **9-Hole Putting Tournament**

Participants putt in a uniquely designed event that would incorporate both the group name and Colorado themes. We can accommodate as many as 40 children per green for this event. Putters, balls and scorecards included. *Total time: 2 Hours*

### **Snag Golf**

Participants hit to velcro targets with oversize clubs and balls. Targets have point values to determine winners. This activity is only applicable to the younger children and always proves to be one of their favorites. This is also a very popular indoor activity in case of inclement weather. *Total time: 1 Hour*

### **Golf Instruction and Etiquette 101**

This activity will be enjoyed by all juniors regardless of their respective ages and playing abilities. We are able to break children into groups for short game, full swing and etiquette instruction that gives them a full overview of the game of golf. Full video instruction is also an important part of our clinic. *Total time: 2 Hours*

### **3-5 Hole Golf Tournament**

Tournaments of this nature are designed by our staff to maximize participation by making the format one that is fun and team oriented. Holes are redesigned by our staff for playability and enjoyment. This tournament is better suited for children who are beginners to intermediate in their playing ability. *Total time: 2 Hours*

### **On-Site 9-Hole Golf Tournament**

This tournament format is used for a more formal outing. Participants should be intermediate to advanced in their playing ability. We play the golf course as it was designed. This provides many creative scoring options. This format can also be easily used for a parent / child tournament. *Total Time: 3-4 Hours*

### **Off-Site 9-Hole Tournament**

We only use this option if time simply does not permit using our own courses due to extremely high levels of play. We can transport children to another nearby facility and arrange for supervised play and some instruction. These tournaments are tailored to fit the participants' varying playing ability and golf knowledge. *Total time: 3-4 Hours*

### **Drive, Chip and Putt Skills Contest**

This contest closely resembles the Golf Channel event held here annually. Participants are rewarded points for accuracy and distance according to the event. Competition is fair because juniors are grouped according to age. Distance handicaps are taken into consideration for gender purposes. *Total Time: 2 Hours*

### **Indoor Activities**

Various golf subjects will be discussed by using an array of props and teaching methods. Instructional mats and books are used to convey swing coaching and golf etiquette. All indoor activities are geared to maximize interaction and fun. *Total Time: 1-2 Hours*

*Safety is always our first priority when conducting group instruction. Professionals will be assigned accordingly to ensure student to teacher ratios that will allow for optimal learning and a safe environment. Instructional fees also vary according to the number of instructors and levels of expertise.
